About the Theological Education Scholarship Fund

Theological Education Scholarships are provided to individuals pursuing a formal course of study leading toward a church vocation through a seminary, ministry degree program, Christian educator degree program, Commissioned Ruling Elder training, lay pastor education curriculum, or professional certificate. They may also be used for continuing pastoral education, internships, contextual education, or study abroad (not including travel abroad), provided any of the foregoing are connected to the degree or certificate program. Theological Education Scholarship candidates must be registered with the Committee on Preparation for Ministry or in consultation with a particular congregation for service. Theological Education Scholarships up to \$2,000 per academic period and no more than twice per calendar year, not based on need, are available using this Application form. Theological Education Scholarships up to the full cost of the educational or degree program based on need are available using the Theological Education Scholarship Application (Need Based), which can be found on the Presbytery's web site or at the Presbytery office. Theological Education Scholarships will not exceed the cost of tuition, fees, books and supplies, and other actual costs incurred.
