

Advice to Juniors

Video Assignment

Make a video about your Capstone experience. These videos will be shown to the junior class during their Term 4 Capstone course. They should be creative and fun to watch. Plus, they should help the juniors feel more prepared for this experience. Here are some suggestions to base your video on. Don't answer ALL of these questions in your video. Pick one or two to be the focus.

- What did you wish you knew about Capstone before your senior year?
- What do you wish you did differently in any aspect of the Capstone process (picking a topic, research, real-world application, collaboration)?
- What did you enjoy about the Capstone process?
- What are you most proud of?
- What did you learn from the Capstone process?

Requirements:

1. The video should be no shorter than 1 minute, but not longer than 3 minutes.
2. The message of the video should be positive.
3. You must provide a viewable YouTube link.
4. Everyone in the group must appear in the video at some point (visually or voice).
