

Nancy Drawe - Housing Authority (5-year)

My name is Nancy Drawe, but I'm mostly known by my nickname, Punky. I'm a candidate for the 5 year term on the Hopkinton Housing Authority, which I currently serve as an appointed member to finish a former members term.

I was born in Hopkinton in 1954, but have moved back and forth from Framingham, finally settling permanently in Hopkinton on Davis Road in 1991.

I really wanted to become involved in the community, so I started out volunteering at the Sr. Ctre as a computer tutor, member of the Volunteer Advisory Committee, and lunch hostess. Two years ago, I was appointed as a member of the Council on Aging board, serving as secretary.

I was trained as a Dementia Friends Champion and am currently volunteering to do Dementia Sessions for the Age/Dementia Friendly Initiative in Hopkinton. We are currently working on some major capital projects such as renovating the laundry room, replacing many of the trees that have been cut down, and installing security cameras on the property.
