Description

Broadcast Writing / Performing Contest

Teams will receive a prompt and will have several hours to prepare a sports commentary broadcast. Up to 4 teams of 1-4 students.

Prompt: Is Taylor Swift good for the NFL?

Make a compelling and entertaining argument.

Deadline

Sunday, November 5th at 2PM

Rules

Only one student can deliver the commentary. You may cast anyone else at all to appear in the video. People you cast can have dialog but the main commentary must come from one person.

Music is allowed if you have the rights to it. Graphics are allowed. Teleprompters are allowed. Editing is allowed. The judges will prioritize thoughtful content and quality commentary over production value alone.

Content: The commentary reveals a knowledge of the topics covered, and presents interesting and unique perspectives.				
Host: The host is engaging, entertaining, and knowledgeable.				
Voice: The host keeps the commentary "authentic" and uses their true voice.				
Impact: The host gives well thought-out perspectives and provides both information and entertainment for the viewer/listener.
