

“Quick and Easy Soap Saver”



Materials: G hook (4.25mm)

1 ball of Peaches & Cream 100% cotton yarn

Stitches:

sc: single crochet

dc: double crochet

Notes:

* Always join to beginning stitch of the each Round*

Always work up your first stitch in the same space you join

Rnd 1: ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 4 ch sp, 3 sc in last ch sp. (Now working on the other side of the ch) sc in next 4 sp, 2 sc in same sp as first sc. Join.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same sp as join, sc in next 5, 2 sc in next 2 spaces, sc in next 5, 2 sc in next 2 spaces. Join

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same sp as join, sc in next 6, 2 sc in next 2 spaces, sc in next 8 sp, 2 sc in next 2 spaces, sc in last sp. Join.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same sp as join, sc in next 8, 2 sc in next, sc in 11 sp, 2 sc in next, sc in last 2 sp. Join.

Rnd 5-19: ch 1, sc in same sp as join. sc in each sp around. Join.

Rnd 20: ch 1, sc in each sp around. Join.

Rnd 21: Ch 2, dc in same sp as join, dc in each sp around. Join.

Rnd 22: Ch 1, sc in same sp as join, sc in each sp around. Join.

Rnd 23: Ch 2, *2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in next* repeat around. Join. Fasten off.

I used 3 2ft pieces of Peaches & Cream and braided them. Weave in and out of Rnd 21
