Essential Question: What constitutes a “series or set” when it comes to ceramics?

Project Objective: Create a series/set of four bowls that connect in **size, shape, and surface treatment**. (Examples at bottom of page)

Link to your pinterest /image board of at least 10 “thrown bowl” pins:				
Find 4 bowls you can touch/hold. Photos of 4 different <u>ceramic</u> bowls from home or a store or the ceramics studio. Put in an image and describe how it feels in your hands*, write what you think is its ideal use.				
*Is it rough? Smooth? Bulgy? Rounded? Flared at the top? Straight-sided?
