Are you working on your college applications? Have questions about the Common App, SRAR, Scoir, etc.? Students can stop down to the counseling office during L1 and L2 to get your questions answered. Sign up with Ms. Fisher in the counseling office. There will be a session every Tuesday. Fill out the [google form](#) and let us know what topics you would like to discuss at the Lunch and Learn time during directed study and lunch periods.

We are well into college application season. Be aware of upcoming deadlines. Please make sure you have completed your [counselor recommendation questionnaire](#) if you need a counselor recommendation letter. Also, hand in your transcript release form 10 school days before the deadline but after you have already submitted your application. For example, for a deadline of December 1, you should have your transcript release form handed in no later than November 15. Do not leave the [transcript release form](#) on your counselors desk or mailbox, please hand it directly to them.
