Policies

Collect data on most taken jobs

This would make those items available in the market, allow for private companies to sell and easily undercut government pricing, and serve as an income stream for the government.

Evaluate prices of goods and services

Pretty much just looking at the prices of exams, medicine, licenses, fees, etc. and seeing if they make sense in the current economic environment.

Take a look at past economic practices

We are fortunate to be in a position where economic interventions were attempted in the past. I'd like to look at what worked and what didn't in order to optimize our efforts to our goals.

Pruning player balances for everyone that has been inactive for a year

Now, this is likely a controversial policy. I'd like to explain my reasoning behind this. Of course, a preliminary step would be to investigate the government's finances, as well as to determine any

changes to this spending that may occur as a result of these economic policies. I'd like to stay on the side of not taxing active citizens, and so I'd like to take a look and see if pruning inactive player balances (of those offline for over a year) could raise sufficient funds. It's money that is in the economy, but isn't in circulation. The increased funds would give us more freedom to implement programs to put that money in the hands of the people.

Working with other departments

I would like to work with other departments, such as the DoPA, to create events or policies that would encourage circulation of money and create opportunities for investment.

Community involvement

I would leave to hear from the community, and so in line with that goal, I would like to create an anonymous poll that is always open, where members of the community can share their complaints, suggestions, or feedback at any time. Additionally, I would like to meet with business leaders, as well as interested members of the community to discuss solutions that would lead to a more productive economic environment.
