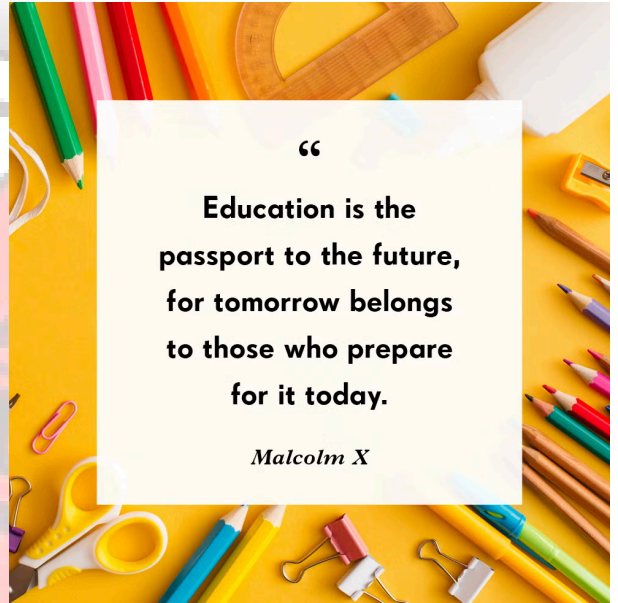

ACADEMIC ASSEMBLY: Friday, August 29, 2025. Grades 7-12 please

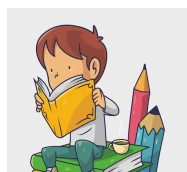
NO SCHOOL: there will be no school on Monday, September 1, 2025.
