Thank you for joining Town Manager Kate Fitzpatrick and me to form the *Town of Needham Schools Emergency Advisory Team (NSEAT)*.

The purpose of NSEAT is to:

- Meet twice yearly to discuss general school health, safety, and security concerns and act as necessary;
- Share private and public school and Town safety and security ideas, information, and updates;
- Coordinate with the Town of Needham's [Local Emergency Planning Committee \(LEPC\)](#);
- Enhance communication between and among private and public school and Town leaders to promote student safety and wellbeing.

NSEAT only acts as a collaborative and advisory committee with a focus on school and student safety. It does not take the place of, oversee, or have authority over other existing private or public school or Town committees. We anticipate meeting no more than two times a year and/or as a specific and critical need arises.

We look forward to working together to ensure our Town's private and public schools and students are safe and secure.
