Some context | Why this invitation

Collaboration has undoubtedly reached the status of buzzword, and this with good reason! The more we become aware of the magnitude of the challenges we face, the more we are recognising the need for collaboration. And with it we are both experiencing the power and the struggle of working together. We are experiencing this tension first-hand with collaboratio helvetica, an initiative co-founded through the collaboration of 7 organisations and dedicated to catalysing collaboration in Switzerland towards the SDGs. While here and there we get a taste of what could be possible, often we are faced with the limits that time, money and our current decision making structures impose on us. How often have you, just like us, wondered:

What if there was a way to experience collaboration both as effective and joyful?

We see that many organisations today are willing to review their decision-making models and experiment with new approaches to governance such as holacracy. For our purposes however, we felt that Sociocracy 3.0 with its pattern language is an approach flexible and organic enough to cater to our need for cross-organisational collaboration.

Our intention is to cocreate with you a space that allows us to not only develop our skills but also engage in meaningful conversations and explore this eco-system's role in transforming Switzerland.

Our aim is to not only introduce Sociocracy 3.0 for collaboratio helvetica internally, but for the ecosystem we feel a part of, want to be active in and collaborate with. This is **why we are inviting you** to this training and to explore some key aspects of collaboration.

More about Sociocracy 3.0 (S3) – www.sociocracy30.org

S3 facilitates conscious collaboration for happier, more effective organisations. All over the world organisations are experimenting with new tools and methods for increasing effectiveness and organisational agility.

One pattern S3 sees emerging in this new paradigm is self-organised, semi-autonomous teams, energised by a personal sense of calling to serve effectively their collective purpose. At the same time it's becoming clear that each organisation's context is unique and that prescriptive, "one size fits all" solutions can cause more harm than good. Regardless of context, sooner or later organisations bump into common areas of concern, including:

- Maintaining engagement and raising self-accountability
- Transforming potential conflicts into creative opportunities to grow
- Tapping collective intelligence to continuously improve and innovate
- Ensuring effective decision making, engaging and productive meetings
- Developing effective ways to organize and coordinate work
- Decentralizing decision making and influence
- Maintaining alignment and scaling without losing soul

Price

In applying the pay-what-feels-right logic we'd like to explore different ways to think (and feel) about value. What is a fee that feels right to you, taking into consideration the costs of this training, your specific financial context and the value of the training? To reduce our risks and give you an orientation we've set the scale with a minimum fee of CHF 450.- and maximum of CHF 1600.-. The average amount each participant would need to pay to cover the costs would be around 800CHF. The fee includes accommodation, food and the training costs. About the course journey

Our journey together will focus mainly on an exploration of S3 principles and processes, consisting of a balanced programme with a combination of theory, practice and reflection.

Day 1 focuses largely on theory and learning about the basic elements of the S3 framework, including an exploration of its principles. Be prepared for learning, un-learning and for your brain to get hot!

Day 2 we move via demonstrations to practice, where you will apply S3 patterns for tapping collective intelligence and decision making, touch base with a few more patterns and review learning so far.

Day 3 continues with reflections on effective ways to pull in S3 patterns in organizations. Later you'll learn about and experience Driver mapping, a pattern that enables fast start-up when a group of people wish to self-organise and collaborate together around a shared Driver. We close with open-space sessions where you can focus attention into areas most supporting integration of course content, and allowing further chances to apply patterns in practice should you choose.
