 On the way to Lake Como/the town of Darby. Walking either up or down the river yields great luck.

Skalkaho Creek

Off the beaten path. Centennial Grove is a great place to park.
 There are picnic tables and a self guided discovery walk through the park to learn more about the flora and fauna. Fishing is a blast but challenging due to brush and thickets that line the creek banks.
