6. Essence (No Last Name)

- Leela Hits Molly with a leela bomb (Poisonrana) dead center in the ring. She pops up to her feet, allowing Deadeye to hit a gut kick and European uppercut, backing her into the nearest set of ropes. Weston rushes her, using Molly's downed body to flip over her and attempt his lariat. Unluckily for him, Leela ducks and sends him over the top rope.
- Essence boots Molly with a bicycle kick, toppling her over the top rope but Barnes holds onto the bottom rope, averting her elimination for the time being. Stefani Biggs shows up and hops the apron, eating a forearm for her troubles. Valencia Ramsey slides into the ring and attacks Essence from behind. She fights her off, tossing her out of the ring. It's only when she turns around and is pelted by that US Championship that we see Essence robbed and eliminated from the match.
- We're down to the final 2. Leela Watts vs Molly Barnes. The Iron Woman vs The Machine. Neither woman shys from stepping in the center of the ring, standing forehead to forehead. They're both fired up at the prospect of facing Carli Davis for her APEX Championship. We get a bit of a match, neither competitor getting an advantage over the other. It isn't until Leela tries for a hurricanrana, sending both of them onto the apron. We get several continuous waistlock trades until Leela hits a back elbow. She shoots for a suplex but Molly wiggles out of it and hits a snap german on the apron, getting her the victory.

Singles Match | 15 Min. Time Limit

Hilary Levandrier

v.

Regina Blake

- Quick tie up, Hilary pushes Regina up into her corner, allowing for the ref to make a clean break. They go at it again, this time with Blake forcing Levandrier into her corner. However, there isn't much of a clean break here as once the referee tries to split them apart, APEX's dentist slaps her opponent across the face. Hilary is hot after that and tries to rush her opponent and runs right into a forearm smash, briefly dropping her to a knee.

- Regina takes advantage of that and rushes her opponent with a quick kneeling snap ddt and a pinfall that only gets a one count. She then picks up Hilary and sets up for a snap suplex but it gets stuffed and the Vixen of Van City lifts her opponent up for a vertical suplex. Blake is a little slow to her feet, prompting Hilary to attempt a running scissors kick. Regina rolls through, effectively dodging the kick before popping to her feet. Levandrier rushes at her opponent, only to get flipped onto the canvas with an arm drag. Hilary spins around, lifting her legs up and pressing his feet against her opponent's chest to kick off perfectly. Regina tries to rush back onto the offensive and it's Levandrier that gets the upper hand with a perfect snap arm drag, mirroring her opponent's actions.
- The match speeds up with both women having an answer for everything they throw at one another, leading toward the corner nearest to the announce table. Blake hits a quick drop kick that backs Hilary into the nearest corner. She then lifts her up, sets her on the top turnbuckle and follows her up there until she gets a handful of right hands that drop her back down. Levandrier wraps her arms around Regina's neck and locks in that rear naked chokehold, Blake flailing around toward the nearby ropes. As a last resort, she dumps Hils over the top rope and onto the apron.
- She walks toward Hilary, only to eat a forearm to the face as the taller of the two reaches over and lifts Regina up for a vertical suplex. Kicking her feet out, Blake eventually lands up on the apron as well and the two duke it out momentarily. Eventually, Regina kicks Hilary's left knee from out under her and lands her dome first onto the hardest part of the ring. She then takes her time to roll her back in, enjoying the Japanese norm of a 20 count.
- Levandrier is rolled into the ring and Regina follows her, waiting for her to get up. She signals for that emergency extraction superkick and as soon as Hilary groggily makes it to her feet, she pulls the trigger. Luckily, Levandrier still has a few tricks up her sleeves and catches her foot, pulling her in for yet another forearm that backs her up a little. Both women then charge each other, hitting synchronized bicycle kicks to their chests and dropping them onto the canvas.
- Hilary is the first to get up, goes for a seated blockbuster that the nimble Blake dodges with her flexibility and ability to lay prone. Popping up, she hits Levandrier with a superkick that knocks her lights out. The end is near when our own DMD hits her R.E.B DMD (panama sunrise) for the victory.

Liberty Hightower ©

v.

Brianna Leigh Clark

- Although both the champion and challenger do not like each other whatsoever, they flow with one another like water. The start of the match has a cool trade of transitions. First, we see Brianna showcase that otherworldly strength with a simple toss of the champ, sending her 3/4s of the way across the ring. She then flexes her right bicep, the Tinkerhulk showing off for the crowd here today. As for the champion, Liberty smoothly gets a wristlock in, switching it into a low waistlock that soon transitions into a chinlock and a foot to the back of the knee that drops her down. As she lets go of the challenger, Hightower makes sure to add insult to injury with a good ol slap to the back of the head.
- Hightower's technical ability is vastly superior to the Hossette's, working her right shoulder with stiff shoulder tackles. Liberty follows that with elbows to the shoulder. Brianna can't get back into it because Liberty continues to keep her down on one knee. The champ is so savvy and so on point tonight, delivering devastating knees to her shoulder that finally drops her to both knees.

- Liberty then hits the ropes and comes back for a running hip attack but that attempt is greeted by a snap release German suplex from Clark. BLC does not look to slow down as she lifts her opponent up for a deadlift stalling fisherman suplex. It's almost a 20 count before she comes down and we can hear Liberty painfully coughing out right through the tv. The Immortal One rolls out of the ring. It looks like she's had enough of this whole match as she makes a break for the timekeeper's table and snatches her title. Clutching onto it, she runs around the ring and up the ramp. Brianna is right behind her with a clubbing blow to the back. She then lifts Liberty up over her head in a military press position and walks towards ringside to toss her inside.
- Liberty is complaining to Matt Hopper about her back, making it painstakingly obvious to everyone but the official that this is meant for a distraction. Like clockwork, here comes Valencia Ramsey, rushing Clark with a handful of strikes. Brianna isn't going to just lay down and die, she fights back with strikes of her own. That is until Stefani Biggs comes into the picture with a huge forearm to the back of the neck. Both members of THE STANDARD hit BLC with synched bicycle knees to the side of the head. They then toss her back into the ring so that Liberty could nail a TEARDROP, the spinning Heel Kick dropping her like a sack of rocks. Liberty hooks the leg and to her surprise, Clark gets a shoulder up at 2.
- Although she's clearly frustrated, Liberty is right back to it, working on that right arm some more. Starting with educated stomps to the shoulder, she elevates to an arm slam to the mat. Both hands press against her arm as she drops a knee right into that shoulder. Matt Hopper gets involved, separating the two to check on Bri's arm. She assures to the official that she can continue and even shows it off with a heavy shoulder tackle that takes the champ off of her feet. Liberty gets up, dusts herself off and then rushes Brianna with all of her might, eating a lariat for her troubles. Apex's Hossette then lifts Hightower up to her feet, over her shoulder and then marches around the ring with her opponent until she drops her down with a heavy powerslam. Lifting her up, she eats a PUNCH INTO ROW Z, the discus fist dropping Hightower flat onto the mat. Liberty takes the near leg and goes for the pinfall.
1... 2... Valencia places Liberty's foot on the bottom rope and steps away. Hopper has to break the count.
- Clark is pissed, rolling out of the ring to give chase. She rushes Valencia with a pouncing tackle that has her crashing into the announcer's table before sliding back in. She then

sees Stefanni Biggs on the apron by the corner and knocks her off with a forearm. Turning around, Liberty is right through her with a Yakuza kick to the face and leaps onto the challenger with a cross armbreaker. There are 24 hours in a day. The sky is blue. Brianna Leigh Clark powers through, lifting the champ high up for a sitout deadlift powerbomb.

1... 2... AND The Standard yank Matt Hopper right out of the ring

- Brianna is beyond heated right now and it shows with a stiff lariat that knocks Valencia's head off. She then picks her up for a powerbomb lift and throws Ramsey onto the barricade. Biggs rushes in and the two muscle babes trade blows for a while until Bri lifts Biggs up for a spinebuster to the floor. She then goes to check on the official, shaking him in an attempt to get the ref back to his senses, to no avail. As our replacement official Robin Danders runs down the ramp, Bri slides into the ring. Unfortunately for the challenger, the champ swoops in like a hawk with a soccer punt kick to the head. Hightower knows this isn't enough and lifts a groggy Clark up with a spinning Heel kick that drops her face first onto the canvas. Liberty is confused as the camera pans in to show Brianna struggling to push herself off of the canvas. She's shaking, she's clearly not all there and yet she makes it to a kneeled position. Liberty takes her head off with another heel kick and gets the pinfall victory.

Tag Team Match | 20 Min. Time Limit

Johnny Amazing & Craig Anderson

v.

Jersey Jim Luzzatto & Dusty Douglas

- Before the match can even start, there are two huge topes by Anderson and Amazing. Craig tosses Jersey Jim into the ring and the match starts. Immediately, this turns into an all out brawl. Luzzatto starts off with clean punches to the forehead of Anderson. He responds with several stinging kicks to the outer thighs and rushes across over for a middle rope springboard roundhouse kick that sends the legend backpedaling.
- Amazing and Douglas are on the outside trading blows before The Murder Machine hits a knee to the gut and starts to land strikes to the back. He then swings and tosses Johnny ribs first into the barricade. Giving chase, dusty is met with a back elbow and a barricade assisted moonsault attack that takes the big man out for the time being.
- Craig is way too fast for Luzzatto, prompting the vet to intentionally shove Robin Eren Danders to the floor. An eye poke later, Anderson is smoked in the jaw with knuckle dusters for the pinfall. Johnny leaps on the apron to make the save but Dusty cuts him off with a low blow. Three count for the more than tainted win.



Singles Match | 15 Min. Time Limit

Jenna Sharpe

v.

Lisa Seldon

- It is announced that the bout has become a No Holds Barred. We get a very serious vibe as both competitors make their separate entrances wearing hand wraps and dressed in street clothing.
- As the bell rings, we get right to work. Sharpe catches Seldon off guard with a waistlock takedown and follows that up with a sharp(e) knee to the back of the neck. She then pops Lisa up, nails a knee to the gut and goes for a Russian Leg sweep but Tango isn't having any of that. She stuffs the sweep, sends Jenna down with a snapmare takedown and then delivers a stiff shoot kick to her back. It was as advertised; honestly sounded like a gunshot. Sharpe winces, grimacing at the feeling of Lisa's leg power. She quickly uses her hands to sweep Lisa down to the canvas with her, climbing her and then locking in a chinlock. This however was followed by a handful of close handed punches that referee Danders couldn't stop. Seldon uses her veteran savviness and outright carelessness to gator roll until both of them took hard falls out of the ring.

- They take a moment to get up but it's Lisa who's on top with a series of headbutts, followed by a sick bite to the face that has Sharpe flailing around. The hellcat then grabs the Canadian Gem by the back of her head and slams her face first into that steel barricade. Sharpe is no slouch and isn't just going to lay down and get beat to death, so she responds with a back elbow to the gut and Irish whips Lisa into the barricade. She's not done as she manages to butterfly suplex her onto the floor; both catching their breaths after the hard fall on the barely padded floor.
- Getting up, they continue to brawl along ringside. Sharpe lands two right hands but a third is blocked, allowing Lisa to respond with a couple stiff roundhouses to the chest. They backpedal all the way toward the announcer section where Lisa drives a forearm into Jenna's chest, sending her onto the Japanese announcer's table. As Seldon makes the climb, Sharpe is quick with a throat jab, giving her the leeway to set up for a leaping backbreaker onto the table. It doesn't give way, making the fall look all the more gnarly.
- The Wildcat feints a punch at Caleb Claudel, stealing his chair before just PELTING Lisa over the head with it. She then rolls Lisa into the ring and gets in herself, setting the chair up in the center. This allows for a gnarly neckbreaker, the chair giving her the huge assist here. She hooks the far leg but we only get a two count. Sharpe is still on the offensive, going right for Seldon's calf. Calf crusher is locked in and Lisa finally pulls her head back in pain, revealing her face painted in her own blood. There's a fight, but Lisa gets a hand onto the ropes.
- An octopus hold by Jenna is turned into an air raid crash, followed by an X-factor. Lisa wipes what she believes to be sweat from her brow, looking in her palm to see her own blood. She nods and begins a barrage of shoot kicks to the stomach and back of the head. Following that is a handful of forearms that would seriously injure a normal person. Sharpe is then lifted up in the air, EVIL DEAD fisherman's driver sending her straight to the mat. A disrespectful forearm to the face is the result of a pinfall by Seldon, but Jenna has her shoulder up at two.
- The Rose Of Calgary is slow to get up, only making it to her hands and knees while Lisa is standing over her. A MAN OPENER attempt is avoided as she slips back, leaps to her feet and lands a discus clothesline. Sharpe turns Seldon over, locking in that bow and arrow submission just to weaken her opponent. What follows that is a knee assisted

chinlock, wrenching back before leaping up and delivering double knees to her lower back. Jenna then goes for her opponent's legs, trying to lock her into what looks like a sharpshooter but Lisa pushes her off and rises to her feet. Sharpe tries for yet another discus clothesline but Lisa ducks under it. She thinks quickly and Seldon is taken down with a whipping flying triangle choke toward the center of the ring.

- It's close, we see Lisa nearly fading on her way toward the ropes, leaping into them as a last result. Referee Danders has to split the two but Sharpe isn't having it. She's got those crazy eyes as she unbuckles her belt and starts to wrap it around Seldon's neck. She unapologetically chokes her for a while until Lisa throws her head back for a headbutt. Seldon begins to fight back with a bevy of elbows and forearms, taking the waist and driving her knees into the Calgary Rose's spine with a backstabber. Kicking her opponent back up to her feet, Lisa sends Jenna head first with a Killacanrana. Double leg pinfall. 1... 2... THR...
- Lisa is sick of it and decides to deliver disgusting looking grounded headbutts to her opponent. After about 10 or so headbutts, we finally see Jenna busted open. Sharpe fights back like a rabid dog, headbutting Lisa as well. They beat the tar out of each other through the middle ropes until Jenna just release snap suplexes Lisa off of the apron and onto the floor.
- Sharpe climbs off of the apron and sets up another chair on the outside. She's not necessarily looking to win anymore as much as she's looking to maim her opponent. A running chair assisted bulldog attempt ends with Lisa just throwing her through it. Seldon then tosses Jenna into the ring and beams her with the broken chair. Jenna, now soaked in her own blood, flips Lisa off as a last sign of resilience before eating a Man Opener, the roundhouse kick straight up taking her out. Seldon then covers Jenna for the pinfall and gets the victory.

A WARNING... Innit?

- Lisa Seldon takes a moment to gather her breath before taking to a microphone. Here she explains that she came here to become a champion. Like it or not, Lisa Seldon is and has always been a belt collector. So CARLI DAVIS,

- This gets the champ's attention as she stands up from her seat at the American commentator booth. Lisa keeps it short and simple; be it her or Molly Barnes, she's taking that title sooner or later. Carli welcomes the challenge and the two share some back and forth off of the mic until Lisa's music hits and she walks to the back.

Singles Match | No Time Limit

Skye Healy ©

v.

Kowloon Zombie

- Both competitors get their time in the limelight. They are not only dressed like stars but they carry themselves with that aura. There's a tie up attempt but Skye ducks it and takes the waist. Kowloon again just shoves her off. There's not much of a height difference between the two but there is a massive size difference. Still, they trade holds with one another for the beginning of the match.
- A wristlock into a headlock by Skye turns into a takedown. Kowloon uses headscissors to sort of reverse that until they both give up on a never ending series of standstills. Healy gets Zombie with a quick hip toss and rushes off for the handspring that Kowloon rolls away from. He then goes for a simple dropkick that Skye sidesteps, leaping for a double foot stomp to the stomach. Kowloon crawls toward the nearest corner, allowing The Lioness to run on in for a Skye Scrapper kick to the head. Kowloon pops her up and lands a sitout powerbomb that gets him a 2 count. She then kicks him in the head, rolls back, hits a solid knee strike and then lands that hip toss, back handspring low dropkick combination for a 2 of her own.
- He picks her up, slaps her and then just effortlessly lifts her up for a vertical suplex. Kowloon lifts her back up and just clobbers her with a step forward leaning forearm to really knock some sense into the champ. Several forearms to the abdomen is then followed by a back suplex and a spinning backbreaker. It all seems to be leading to a torture rack, which he ends up setting up for. He's up there for a while with her but the champion isn't too fond with tapping out, so he spins her frame into a modified blue

thunder bomb. Zombie makes the cover but yet again the champ gets her shoulder up at 2.

- Lifting her up, he goes for a bodyslam but she slips out, landing a reverse DDT. She tries to go up top the nearest corner but Kowloon is there to stop her half way. Several forearms to the lower back is then followed with a deadlift carry and a bridging back suplex with a pin. Skye kicks out immediately, they both get up to their feet and start to trade forearms. Healy responds with like 4 straight right hands and then hits the ropes, coming in just for Zombie to catch her with a black hole slam. A cover then leads to a 2.9 count.
- He lifts her up to her feet, tosses her around before whipping her across the ring. She rebounds off and he goes for a second black hole slam but Skye gets out of it. She then boots him right in the knee, runs across the ring for a handspring and Kowloon catches her with a German suplex. He then picks her up and whips her to the corner across the ring, running in for a boot. She sidesteps him before running in for a yakuza kick of her own, following that up with a Skye High frog splash and gets a pinfall victory.

Calling Upon A Demon Will Only Bring You Hell

- Skye Healy is awarded all of her titles, looking like a knightess with a suit of GOLD. She's then handed a microphone that she snatches away, letting the fans know that she is UNDENIABLE. There isn't a single wrestler in the world that can beat her and as of today, there isn't a Zombie that can beat her.
The light cut out.
- When they cut back on, we get a collected gasp out of the people in attendance as Unified DTW Champion Aokigahara Zombie stands behind Skye. She slowly turns, drops the mic and then immediately backpedals away from her. Aoki grabs the microphone and lets her know that she will indeed die a beautiful death inside of the TOKYO DOME.
- Skye is taken aback. We end tonight on a huge note. A major debut! Here in Apex Wrestling.
