To ensure the timely processing of continuation funding, in the event grants are extended, please submit the following documentation to AIVRS250N@ed.gov by May 8, 2026.

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Official Tribal Letter: A formal certification letter from the Tribe confirming their capacity to continue the AIVRS program grant activities defined in the approved grant application.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ Year 6 Budget: A completed ED 524 Form including both Federal and Non-Federal funds.
3. \_\_\_\_\_ Budget Narrative: A detailed narrative aligned with the figures provided in the ED 524 Form.
4. \_\_\_\_\_ Carryover:
  - a. Total amounts encumbered through September 30, 2026:       \$ \_\_\_\_\_

  - c. Indirect Cost Rate Agreement: A copy of the Tribe's most current agreement.

Important Considerations:

1. Award Totals: Year 6 continuation awards will be based on the approved funding levels for Year 5, however, based on large available balances, there may be a need to reduce continuation funding. The goals and objectives from Year 5 of the approved grant application will remain in effect for Year 6.
2. Budget/Plan Revisions: If the Tribe anticipates any changes to the budget or intends to add new activities, you must consult with your RSA Program Officer no later than May 5 2026.
