Professional Development

Arc of the Year

Overview

Novel's professional development Arc of the Year is the ultimate embodiment of our mantra **for big results, start small**.

Just like a scope in sequence in the curriculum, over the course of each year, a literacy program must break up professional development time into discrete arcs and phases. Each arc focuses on an intentional and narrow set of foci that build on one another. By building strength in these competencies over time, we increase the likelihood that we have time and space to build proficiency in them all.

The **Novel Leader Institute** series breaks our arc of the year up into two arcs, and each arc centers primarily on one element of our arc Essentials rubrics, the aligned coaching skills that support teachers to build those skills, and the desired student learning outcomes we aim to achieve.

Arc 1 is focused on Creating Conditions for Independent Learning. Arc 1 has two phases - the first phase focuses on the first 30 minutes of the lesson, and the second phase focuses on the last 30 minutes of the lesson. We establish a vision for strong student engagement and cognitive lift across the entire lesson, and what supports and scaffolds we can proactively put in place so that all learners have access to the texts and tasks. We focus our coaching and professional development on supporting teachers in how to maximize student participation and cognitive lift and how to provide scaffolds that give students at-bats with grade level work.

Arc 2 is focused on Response to Data. We establish a vision for how teachers should use student data gathered through the lesson or through the study of students' work to provide feedback, facilitate discussion, and plan for small group support. We focus our coaching and professional development on equipping teachers with the skills needed to collect and respond to data throughout the lesson.
