Instagram Writing Project Guidelines:

- 1. Collect **3-5** objects that are the most meaningful to you--use planning guide to prepare if needed.
- 2. Take a photo or bring them in a bag/box
- 3. Post on Instagram with unique hashtag (#chiltonsummer) if you have Instagram.
- 4. **300 word minimum, 1 paragraph about each object** describing the symbolism of the objects in the "Instagram Writing Project" assignment on Google classroom.

About the writing assignment:

- Not a traditional "essay"
- Numbered paragraphs about each item
- Practice using those key verbs: symbolize, represent, illustrate, exemplify, signifies, embodies, indicates, shows, etc.

Don't: Simply list, make claims that are self-evident, bore us with telling us what we already know.

<u>**Do:**</u> Describe interesting backstories of the history of objects, tell **why** this object is symbolic or significant about you, use key verbs: symbolize, represent, illustrate, exemplify, signifies, embodies, indicates, shows, etc.

Presentations:

*Must change Instagram settings to "public" **temporarily** the day you present.
