I use Plagiarism check programs to check for any plagiarism. Make sure that none of the information is copied and pasted into the project. You can read the article and put it into your own words and cite your sources in the Works Cited page.

You may choose any famous **African American person**. For example, you can use Condoleezza Rice, Oprah Winfrey, Michael Jordan, etc.

Include information in a chronological (it MUST make sense) order:

- Where was this person born? In what year?
- Where did this person grow up?
- What does/did the person do for a living?
- Why is this person famous? What did/does this person do to become famous?
- How has this person made an impact on others' lives?
- Quotes and interesting information about this person
