Bus Students

As a reminder, students who ride the bus to and from school have to wear a mask as this is mandatory on any public transportation.

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

It is very important to me to keep your children safe and to also be respectful of your time. If you drop your child(ren) off in the morning, this message is for you. The sidewalk in our parent drop-off area (located in the parking lot closest to the bus garage) is long enough to create multiple drop-off points to speed up your morning. If you are dropping off your child(ren), please keep in the drop-off circle and have your child ready to exit the vehicle as soon as you are stopped in front of the sidewalk. With multiple cars dropping off at one time, this will save time for all parents in the morning. Additionally, we ask that you do not drop your child off in the parking lot unless you are escorting them to the building yourself. This will keep all of our children safe. We will have staff in the drop-off area in the morning to help aid in the process. Included is a link to a visual representation of our drop-off area. [Drop-off/Pick-up Visual](#)

If you are planning to pick your child up at the end of the day, you have two options. First, you can remain in your car and stay in the pick-up line located on the perimeter of the parking lot closest to the bus garage (along the football and baseball areas). Your child will wait for you on the sidewalk and can enter your vehicle once you have made it up to that area and stopped. Second, you can park your car in the lot closest to the bus garage and walk up to the school to meet your child. Most parents stand around the pine tree area closest to the school. However, you are allowed at this time to enter the building to pick-up your child. Please wait until the bell rings to enter the building using the main canopy entrance.

Please Note: The parking lot by the basketball hoops/cafeteria will be the location of our bus loading and unloading and cars will not be permitted in that area during school hours.

Water Bottles

Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle to school. We do have multiple water fountains with filling stations that students can use instead. The bottle should be clear/transparent when possible and labeled with the student's name.
