Be it resolved that \$256,131.19 be appropriated to the Colorado River BOCES from Fund Balance to the General Fund as specified in the 2022-2023 Budget, as presented, for the purpose of subsidizing Yampah Mountain High School and the Rebound Satellite site start-up costs. Be it resolved that \$141,422 be appropriated to the Colorado River BOCES Activity Fund for the ensuing fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023.
