Experience

Allegis Group - Jan 2019-Present - Product Developer Lead

After the successful implementation of ePBCS for one operating company, all current on-premise Hyperion applications were migrated to the cloud at Allegis Group. I was the lead of a team that would go from 5 to 9, and facilitate the implementation of FCCS, EDMCS, TRCS, EDMCS and multiple ePBCS instances in the cloud. Once implementation was complete my team was responsible for all further support and enhancements for all products. This included onboarding other operating companies to ePBCS, enhancing current processes, performance tuning, security auditing, and monthly patch testing and validation.

Allegis Group - Oct 2014-Dec 2018 - Hyperion Developer Lead

I became the lead developer on the upgrade of Hyperion Planning, 11.1.1.3 to 11.1.2.3.500, and the installation of Hyperion Financial Management(HFM). This upgrade also moved the environment to a new data center on a 100% virtual stack, expanding from three servers to eight. HFM, using DRM and FDMEE, pulled in four different multicurrency General Ledgers across the globe.

In 2018 I was lead on a roll out of ePBCS for one of our operating companies and architect for the remaining companies to migrate from on-premise to cloud. The first ePBCS

implementation consisted of 50 users, 11 business rules, 15 forms, and 14 reports. My responsibilities consisted with design, training, testing, data load, and EPMAutomate build out. Following implementation I was the team lead, managing 5 personnel to maintain both on-prem and Cloud products.

Allegis Group - Oct 2011-2013 - PS/Hyperion Developer

As a PeopleSoft Developer I worked on supporting existing applications, troubleshooting SQR, and application engine failures in PS. The Hyperion Planning application, along with the Oracle Data Integrator ETL, was also managed by our team. I developed a web based front end for ODI for executing, and monitoring scenarios for Planning, that was used by multiple companies within our organization. In November 2013 I became the Lead Developer on Hyperion Essbase, Planning, and ODI after creating applications and one year of supporting the environment.

Allegis Group - Oct 2009-Oct 2011 - Support Team Lead

As lead I managed eight analysts supporting the emerging operating companies of Allegis Group. These companies were spread across the globe and operated four in house applications along with a robust virtual desktop architecture.
