## **Course Overview**

The course is designed for undergraduate students who have A1 and above English language level, are interested in watching films and want to improve their spoken English and start watching films in English. At each lesson of the course, students will watch a film or part of a film in the original language and complete communication tasks that reflect the variety of real-life communication situations So, the aim of the course is to develop students' EFL speaking skills and subskills in a variety of topics.

## **Learning Objectives**

Upon successful completion of the course, students will be able to use the English language to:

- Watch English-language films in the original according to their level of language proficiency.
- Ask and answer questions effectively.
- Express their opinions clearly.
- Compare and contrast various topics.
- Engage in discussions and exchange ideas.
- Argue persuasively and convince others.
- Paraphrase and explain concepts proficiently.

### **Course Outline and Teaching Methodology**

The course is taught in the form of practical classes (60 hours) and the organisation of independent work of students (60 hours). The teacher will use communicative and interactive teaching methods.

A course page will be created on Unicom where students can download all the necessary materials for the class, as well as have access to audio, video and other materials for independent work on the course.
