Diversified Occupations (DO) Program

What is it?

Available to SENIORS ONLY interested in developing career competencies in a state-approved career and technical pathway. In this full year program, seniors will earn two school elective credits through gaining general career, technical, and safety instruction on both a job placement site (1 credit) and in the classroom (1 credit).

What do I need to apply?

Interested students must complete the application process by July 1 prior to the start of their senior year. Approved DO students must commit to one instructional period during the normal school day and to working a minimum of 15 hours a week for the entire school year when enrolled in the program. Reliable transportation to and from job placement sites must be arranged by and is the responsibility of the student. All seniors participating in the DO Program must remain in good academic, attendance, and disciplinary standing.

What will I gain?

An opportunity to integrate career and technical training with academic studies while earning a one elective credit elective for the classroom portion as well one elective credit while broadening their depth of understanding in a paid work based learning experience aligned with their chosen career and technical pathway. Students who qualify will also have the opportunity to sit for the NOCTI 21st Century Employability Skills Certification Exam, become OSHA 10 certified, become First Aid and CPR Certified, and obtain three college credits through our articulation agreement with Pennsylvania College of Technology or Harrisburg University.

How do I apply?

Discuss your specific interests with your school counselor to be sure you are eligible and qualify for the Diversified Occupations Program. Obtain the application form to be completed, signed, and returned as soon as possible. Interested students must complete the application process no later than July 1 prior to the start of their senior year.
