


# **ASW Part I Tests**


# Logging in

In your web browser, go to the website <a href="https://aswbee.com">https://aswbee.com</a>.

Change to the teacher login screen by clicking the "Click here to login as a teacher" link.



Enter your login name and password from the license email.




Click the "Login" button. Note: The team name is not used when teachers log in.




#### **Password**

Your dashboard will appear.



When you log in for the first time, we suggest that you change your password.

Just click the "Change your password" button and enter a new password. Passwords are case-sensitive.



Please note that our company cannot ever see or recover your password, so make sure that you remember it.


#### Name your team


The first step in setting up your team for the year is to give it a team name. The team name is used by the student, along with his or her login name, to log into the system.

#### There are 2 rules to remember:

- The team name must be unique in ASW Bee for the current school year.
   Note: If you have more than one ASW Bee license (example: you're using both ASW Part I Tests and ASW Spelling Tests), each must have its own unique team name.
- 2. The team name should be easy for your students to remember.


To set the team name, click the "Set your team's name" button on the dashboard and enter your team's name. Note the "Help" link on the form. Clicking "Help" links throughout the program will display helpful information.






## Add your students

Once the team name is set, the "Add a student" button will be visible in the dashboard.



To add students to your team, click the "Add a student" button.



There are 2 rules to remember:

- 1. The student's name (first + middle + last) must be unique for your team. Middle name is not required but can be used to make the student's name unique if needed.
- 2. The student's login name must be unique for your team.

For the student's login name, we suggest using the student's first name. If this would make two students have the same login name, use their last name, add their last initial, or add a number - basically anything to make a unique login name for each student.

The student's password does not have to be unique, so you are free to use a different password for each student or the same password for all students. Passwords are case-sensitive.

You are in charge of the student's password, which means:

- The students cannot change their passwords.
- You can always see each student's password in case the student forgets it.
- You can change the student's password if necessary.

#### You're ready to go!

The student can now go to <a href="https://aswbee.com">https://aswbee.com</a> and login using his/her team name, login name, and password.


## Checking student progress

After a student takes and saves a test, you will be able to see his/her results.


To do this, click the small gradebook in the corner of the student button to see the latest results.




You can see the test number, number of attempts, timestamp, and score of the latest test.



If you click the test row, you will be able to see and print the results of the latest attempt.



If you want to administer a printed test or print the list and/or test for the student to take home, click the "View the tests" button from the dashboard. From here, select the test, then click the "Print" button. The word list will be presented along with a printed test and key.



Students can print individual word lists from their program as well.

#### Other things...

You will always have access to these instructions from the "Help" button on the dashboard.



- You can print student instructions for your spellers as needed. Students can access the instructions from our website as well.
