First to make this I made a trace of the outline. To do that I used ovals to do the arms and shoulders, and I used circles to do the head and torso. For the hands I used one big circle as the palm and ovals as fingers. After I got the shape of the body I created a new layer and curved everything out, adding dimensions. When I added the curves and dimensions I had my final outline.

After that I added the skin color and drew a shirt on her, for the dripping teddy bear I had a reference photo, the second photo, so I

copied colors of it and matched it the best I could but changed a few things because of copyright.

For the tattoos I only had one inspiration, the third picture. I copied it but didn't add an initial, but the rest of the tattoos are just randomly made.

For the eye, I added an oval shape with a curved eye liner eye lash. And colored it in the color of the eye from the upper left corner, (My inspiration picture) for the eyebrow I drew a line and messed around with it until I liked it.

For the hair I kept it pretty simple, And I colored it a dark blue, close to navy. And as you go down looking at the hair you can see it fades very lightly to a lighter color to simulate shine. And a small detail I added is strands of hair.

Lastly for the lips I took the skin color but faded it to pind and used the blur tool to create shine and blend it with the skin then I added a line for the nose and a line for the mouth.

I also made sure to add tiny details in the drawing to keep attention and to draw in more observers. I also added a fair amount of dark colors to light colors.

Then we have our final product.
