Topic: The dangers of labeling others

Overview for facilitator:

Lesson has students reflect on labels used to describe individuals in society.

Materials Needed:

Intro:

What are labels? What do we mean when we say that some groups or some individuals are labeled by others?

Discussion/Activity:

Have students reflect on the following prompts. Students can share out in small groups, whole group, or reflect individually on paper/online.

- 1. Where do we get ideas about the labels we use to describe other individuals and groups of people?
- 2. Are labels ever useful?
- 3. Are labels ever dangerous or negative?
- 4. How do you feel when society or another individual labels you?
- 5. How can you be more aware of the labels you use on others?

Returning as a full group, have students go around sharing the following (as always, any student can pass)
