Requirements and Selection Criteria

2. Applicants must be T.L. Hanna High School students.
3. Applicants must be current year high school seniors.
4. Applicants must have been accepted to and committed to attending a 2 or 4 year college/university. An acceptance letter must be submitted with the application.
5. Applications must be returned to TLH Guidance by March 27, 2026.
6. The amount of \$1000.00 will be awarded for the year **2026**.
