

Ready, Set, Graduate! 🎉 Your Frequent Grad Questions, Answered

When is graduation?	Monday, June 9, 2025 at 10:00 am at DAR Constitution Hall. Graduates must arrive between 8:45 - 9:20 a.m. Graduates must be at their place in line by 9:20 a.m. Doors open for guests at 9:00 am and temporarily close between 9:45 - 10:10 am. DAR gives us a 2 hour maximum, so the ceremony will end by 12:00pm.
Where can I watch the live stream of the ceremony?	The link will be posted on the MCPS website.
What should I do if I could not attend the graduation information meetings?	Here is the link to the information <u>slides</u> . Additional information can be found on the <u>WHS Graduation</u> <u>website</u> .
Where do I pick up my tickets?	The parent/caregiver can pick up the tickets from Ms. Julia Walsh in the Finance Office between 8am-2pm on any school day. If you prefer to have the student pick them up, please send Ms. Walsh an email at Julia_G_Walsh@mcpsmd.org giving the student permission to pick them up.
How do I request extra tickets?	Use <u>this link</u> to request extra tickets. We have an extremely limited number of tickets remaining.
When is the last day for seniors?	Friday, May 23, 2025
When do I get my cap and gown?	Graduates receive their cap, gown, stole and tassel at the end of graduation rehearsal. Rehearsal is THURSDAY, June 5, 2025 from 8:45 am - 12:00 pm in the main gym.
Can I wear stoles, cords , etc?	Honor regalia must be school issued. All students receive a Wootton Class of 2025 stole and tassel. Any other decor can be saved for photos after the ceremony.

Can I decorate my cap ?	Yes! Make sure it follows these guidelines: Caps MAY: Include graduation year Recognize the university or college you will be attending, place of employment, branch of the military you will be joining Recognize high school activities (sports, club, or co-curricular activities) Thank a parent, grandparent, family member, teacher, friend Caps MAY NOT include: Anything that makes noise (bells, whistles, horns) Advertisements, symbols, abbreviations, initials, words, slogans, or pictures that are or refer to drug, gang, alcohol, weapons or sexual content Logos, words, sayings or any action of hate or bias, or depict discriminatory symbols Anything obscene, profane, vulgar, or lewd Numbers other than the graduation year. Anything that threatens the safety and welfare of any person.
