Each response will be scored on a scale of 1 to 3 for a total of 15 points maximum.

- 1.** Describe your relevant skills, knowledge, and lived experience (noting salient aspects of your identity) as well as any volunteer, work, and/or educational experience that would serve the Riverdale community as a member of the District Educational Equity Advisory Committee to meet its mission of monitoring and providing advice and recommendations to address historic and current equity gaps to both the RSD Board and Superintendent.
- 2.** Please provide a brief statement about WHY you are interested in being on the RSD Educational Equity Advisory Committee. What excites you about the possibility of serving in this role?
- 3.** If selected and appointed to serve, what would you hope to accomplish during your service on the RSD Educational Equity Advisory Committee?
- 4.** Please describe how you collaborate with people who have different perspectives and lived experiences than your own.
- 5.** Please share examples of your experience supporting and/or advancing racial equity and social justice. Refer to examples from: your school, work, community, family, etc. Please share your experience, if any, in serving on an advisory committee.
