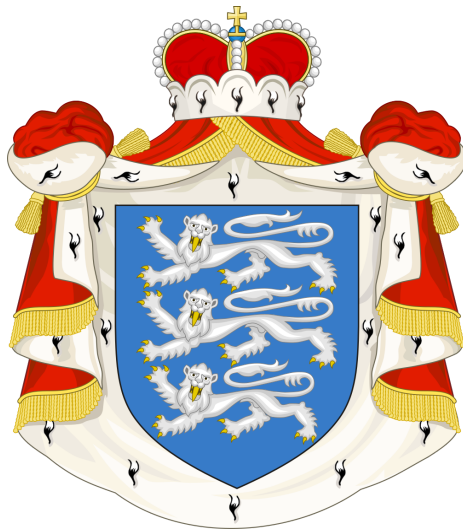




Charter of Civil Liberties and Rights

Every citizen should know their rights and responsibilities to avoid problems.

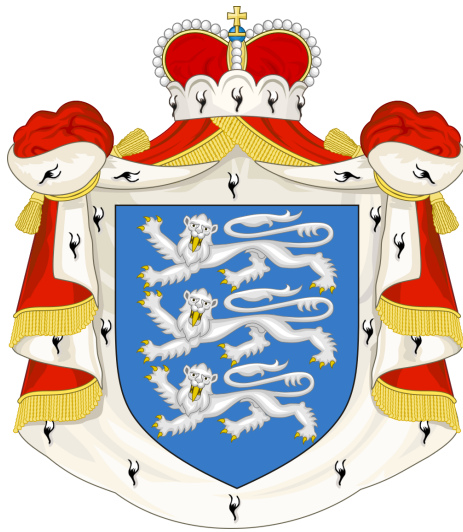
CIVIL RIGHTS

1§

Citizens have the right to freedom of expression.

2§

The citizen has the right to be informed about internal events in or around Mendersia.



3§

Every Mendersian citizen is guaranteed freedom of religion or can establish their own religion.

4§

A citizen of Mendersia has the right to petition. The details shall be regulated by law.

5§

A citizen may declare a demonstration, but must inform about the course of the demonstration.

6§

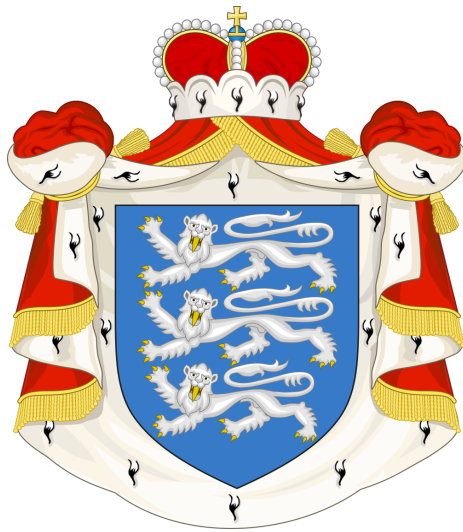
The right to vote is from the age of 8.

6.1§

In an election, a Monarch can choose whether or not to vote, but if he does not, he will not be counted in the turnout..

7§

The right to be elected starts at the age of 10.



8§

The right of resistance belongs to every citizen. Citizen can demonstrate against the move or write a petition to have it reversed.

9§

All people are equal in the territory of Mendersia, regardless of their citizenship, skin color, sexual orientation, cultural differences or other political views, for example.

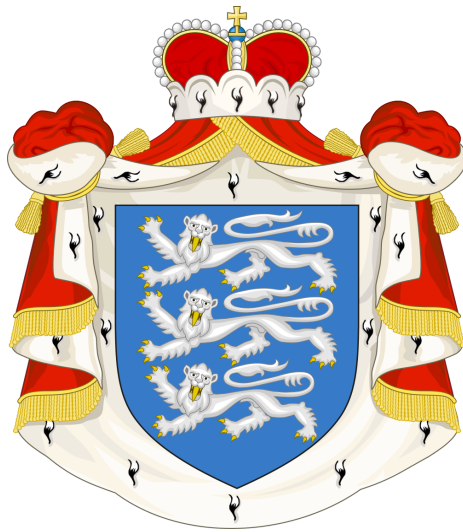
SECOND PART

1§

Charter shall enter into force on the date of approval by the Council of the Nation.

2§

The Charter may be modified if at least 60% of the members of the Council of the Nation agree.
