Willard Zoom Rules and Expectations For Distance Learning 2020/21

In a virtual classroom just like in a real classroom, we expect all our Willard students to follow the 4 B's. Be safe, Be respectful, Be responsible, Be kind. Here is what that looks like while on Zoom.

1. Be Safe on Zoom:

- a. We encourage all students to have their video on, but it is not required. You may use audio only if that makes you feel more comfortable.
- Students can only have pictures of themselves as their Zoom profile picture and it must be school appropriate (i.e. no inappropriate language or symbols on clothing and no provocative poses)
- c. Use school appropriate language at all times, both verbally and in the chat
- d. To enter class students must use their rostered name or an alternative that has been pre-approved by the teacher. Unknown names will not be admitted.

2. Be Respectful on Zoom:

- a. Keep yourself muted unless it is your turn to speak.
- b. Listen to others or work quietly (on mute) until it's your turn
- c. Keep comments about others to yourself
- d. No student recording or filming of Willard zoom sessions

3. Be Responsible on Zoom:

- a. Show up to your teachers' scheduled office hours per their directions
- b. Have questions and discussion responses ready per teacher directions
- c. Be focused on your class. Do not browse the internet or use other devices during class time unless directly instructed to by your teacher

4. Be Kind on Zoom:

- a. Be kind, understanding, supportive and encouraging to both your classmates and your teachers.
- b. Check in and let your teacher and classmates know how you're doing.
- c. Keep all language appropriate and thoughtful. Try to spread kindness.
