

## TIPS

- Cause and Effect claim and contains **NO pronouns or EMPTY words (we, you, things etc)**  
*Like a harsh teacher, adversity is needed if a person is to achieve his true potential*
- Evidence develops the 'effect' side of the claim  
*Like a harsh teacher, adversity is needed if a person is to achieve his true potential (Evidence shows how the person's true potential was shown)*
- Warrant - **MUST** be simple and easily understood and applicable to most situations  
*Most kids want to fit in with their peers.*
