- District Responsibilities
 - Develop thoughtful, accessible E-Learning/Remote Learning plans.
 - Support our schools in planning and implementing E-Learning/Remote Learning plans.
 - Help schools and teachers identify needed resources in support of the E-Learning/Remote Learning plans.
- School Responsibilities
 - Implement E-Learning/Remote Learning plans.
 - Communicate regularly and effectively with parents and students.
 - Support teachers in the planning and implementing of E-Learning/Remote Learning plans.
- Teacher Responsibilities
 - Post/make available E-Learning/Remote activities/assignments in a timely manner.
 - Be available at scheduled times to answer student/parent questions.
 - Provide timely feedback to students/parents.
 - Communicate regularly and effectively with students and parents.
- Student Responsibilities
 - Review assigned work/material.
 - Complete assigned work/tasks by the assigned date.
 - Ask questions when you need help.
- Parents/Guardians
 - Review work/material assigned to your student(s).
 - Create a space for students to complete their assignments.
 - Encourage students to develop appropriate sleep patterns.
 - Set sensible time limits for use of technology.
 - Talk to students about their work daily.
 - Help students establish and follow daily routines.
