Recruitments

We're continuing development of the recruitment checkpoints tool with the addition of the **affirmative action goals**. Recruit administrators can choose to require all new recruitments have affirmative action goals in order for analysts to submit a search plan for approval.

Continuing our project to update the recruitment reports, we have **updated the recruitment search report PDF**. The update will provide a better user experience to approvers and other report users, and will also allow us to more easily make future improvements to the report's architecture.

When training users, it is very time consuming to create multiple fake recruitments for the users to practice on. In order to make the training setup easier, we have created a tool that will **allow trainers to create fake applicants and insert them into existing recruitments.** This allows trainers a greater variety of recruitment configurations that can show off different aspects of the application.

Multi-level recruitments

We have added the field **applicant instructions**, an open field on multi-level recruitments that directs applicants to the correct level to select, into the recruitment checkpoint tool. Enabling this field as a requirement should ensure that approvers will not need to send back a pending search plan due to a lack of instructions.
