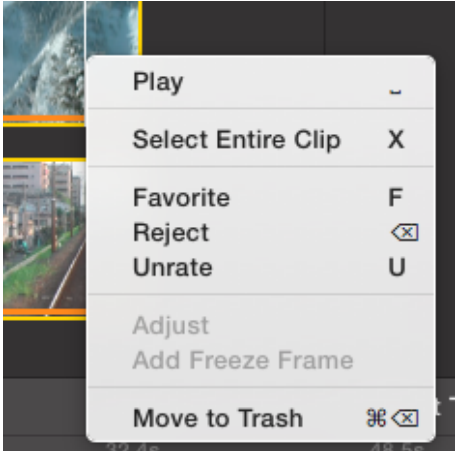
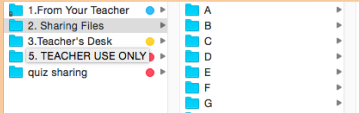
This test will evaluate if you are able to IMPORT footage.

YOU will NOT actually have a memory card to use for this test... normally you WOULD have a memory card, today for testing purposes, you are going to import footage that is on the computer instead of on the card.

EDITING STEPS	DESCRIPTION	
1. GROUPWORK <i>normally this would be done with a group. Today, you will do this on your own.</i>	1.1  Import Click the import button Select the <u>import to</u> drop down menu Create a NEW event Name it: RAWimporttest	
2. GROUPWORK <i>normally this would be done with a group. Today, you will do this on your own.</i>	2. Navigate to where the footage is: GMHS Groupshare > GMHSVideo > Video1 Groupshares > 1.FromYourTeacher > Test-Quiz > Import Test	
3. GROUPWORK	Select all of the footage in the IMPORT TEST FOLDER	
4. GROUPWORK	Click IMPORT ALL	

5. GROUPWORK	Once it is imported. Change the clip viewer to the settings shown -----> Start by clicking this icon  when the dropdown appears, select zoom to all, and set the clip size to a size that you are comfortable with.	
6. GROUPWORK	You should now see all of the clips in your IMPORT TEST event.	
7. GROUPWORK <i>on one person's computer only</i>	 Choose: No theme	
8. GROUPWORK	Name: ImportTest Event: Import Test	
9. GROUPWORK	Select all of the clips from the IMPORT TEST event DOUBLE click one clip to select it (it will show you a yellow outline) then hit COMMAND A (to select all), or hold down COMMAND while you select each clip individually	

10. GROUPWORK	Drag all of the raw (unedited) footage from the event area to the timeline area. You should see ALL of the separate clips that you have filmed. Every time that you STOPPED and then STARTED recording with the camera, it created a new video clip	
11. GROUPWORK	7. After all the footage is on the timeline: SHARE the footage so that all group members will have access to the files, and so that they are stored in your group's shared folder for backup. Click SHARE , then click  FILE	
12. GROUPWORK	Name it IMPORTTEST-LASTNAME uncheck add to theatre	
13. GROUPWORK	Export this to: TODAY ONLY: Save to your DESKTOP Groupshares ... Sharing Files > Quiz Sharing > ImportTest TODAY ONLY: Save to your DESKTOP	
14. GROUPWORK	<i>DELETE ALL OF THE FOOTAGE FROM YOUR TIMELINE and EVENTS. Select ALL then hit CONTROL CLICK & hit DELETE</i> <i>Select all footage on your timeline, then press CONTROL and click your timeline clips when the pop up appears click on DELETE</i>	

15. GROUPWORK	Next, go to your import test <i>EVENT</i> and select all of the footage. Press control then click on your clips and select <i>MOVE TO TRASH</i>	
16. WHY? DID WE DO ALL OF THIS?	<i>MOST IMPORTANTLY: This is how you will share footage with your group.</i> <i>This also allows everyone to start with the same footage</i> <i>This allows me to assess that you are able to utilize this software and prepare for the objectives of this course</i>	
NOTE:	<i>For class purposes:</i> NO... you can NOT just put the memory card into the computer for each group member. You MUST follow this procedure every time that you create a video in this class.	Your group will be given a grade for having the raw footage in the sharing files folder 
NEXT	THIS IS WHERE YOU WOULD NORMALLY START YOUR INDIVIDUAL EDITING
