Frequently Asked Questions About the Library!

Why are there passes for second lunch?

The pass system has been instituted due to large amounts of food crumbs found after second lunch. Crumbs were found on bookcases behind books, on chairs and the floor many times. There are signs posted everywhere you look requesting no food in the library. We checked after both lunches for a few weeks and found that the majority of the issue was coming from second lunch.

The pass system will be in place for the remainder of the first semester. We will reset to no passes unless the issue arises again.

Where do I get a pass for second lunch?

Anyone can get a pass for second lunch in the morning that you will use it. Passes will be given until 10:45 AM (just after the start of 3rd period). <u>No one is</u> <u>banned completely from the library.</u> You may be asked to refrain from coming during lunch for a period of time, but that is not permanent and does not include class time or other times of the day.

Why can't we go to the library for the full lunch period?

As stated above, there is no eating in the library. We don't open the library until the second 20 mins to give students time to eat all of their food in the designated areas for eating on the first floor.

School accounts after graduation?

Plan to have all documents and information you want to keep moved to a personal account or computer by the end of your last day of classes. Why was the entrance moved?
