7 Help students get "unstuck" while coding at home. Maintain existing independent work habits or strategies developed in your classroom.

- Remind children of rubber duck debugging techniques or Harvard's Getting Unstuck Strategies. Encourage students to debug code with a stuffed animal, pet or silent family member.
- Encourage peer support of CS challenges through video conferencing breakout groups for peer teaching, cooperative learning groups or student-managed "Help Desk" protocols.
