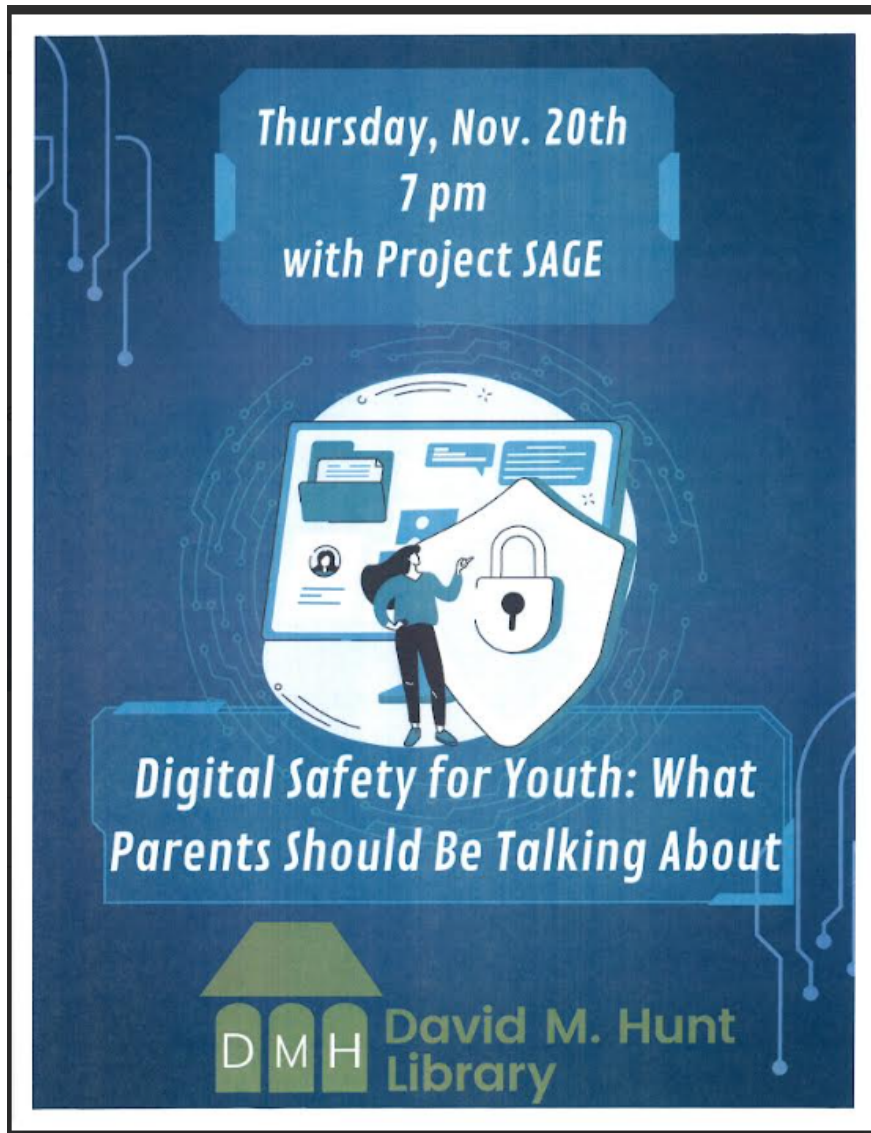

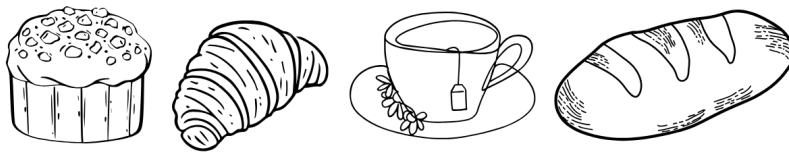
Tea, Bread, Local Spreads and Conversation
