

## Cranford High School

### 2026-2027 Shared Time Students (1/2 day) attending UCVT High School programs

This letter is to notify you of bus options for morning pick up and afternoon drop off locations for Cranford High School students attending shared time (1/2 day) high school programs at Union County Vo-Tech campuses.

There will be two morning bus stops available. For the morning session it would be advisable for students to be at the bus stop at least **10 minutes** in advance of the scheduled pick up time.

Students will be dropped off at Cranford High School following the completion of their morning session at Union County Vo-Tech. The remainder of their school day will continue at Cranford High School.

**Students enrolled in afternoon sessions at Union County Vo-Tech programs will be picked up at Cranford High School at approximately 12:10 P.M. only, and may, if they choose, ride the Cranford Community Center bus to return to Cranford if their home address is closer to that location.**

NOTE: There are no late buses in either direction. Therefore if a student misses their bus, there are no transportation options available in either direction. It is imperative that students are aware of bus departure times to/from Union County Vo-Tech Campuses.

The buses run independent of Cranford Public Schools and Cranford Board of Education. Students attending UCVT programs should follow UCVT school year calendars, not Cranford Public Schools calendar. This applies to Shared Time Students also. There are occasions where UCVT is in session and Cranford Schools are not and visa-versa. The same applies to inclement weather scenarios. **Inclement weather bus information is available on our website, [cranfordschools.org](http://cranfordschools.org), under 'For Parents/Guardians'.**

The Cranford Board of Education, as a school district, works with Union County Educational Services Commission to initiate and coordinate these routes. Beyond that, Cranford Board of Education is not involved nor, are we made aware of any situations that may occur. It is Union County Educational Services Commission who oversees the two routes, not Cranford Public Schools or Cranford Board of Education.
