

Sierra Expeditionary Learning School Project



Project Summary:

The Sierra Expeditionary Learning School (SELS) Project included painting interior and exterior of the buildings; adding sinks to the classrooms; enhancing the enrichment lab casework; a reconfigured parking lot and drop off areas, ADA improvements; adding an entry plaza; installing exterior lighting and fencing; adding hardcourts and update technology infrastructure.

Total Project Budget: \$1,403,000

The SELS Project was completed in two phases; the first phase addressed restroom and classroom improvements including the addition of sinks. The second phase included the parking lot and exterior improvements.
