Returning 4-H Youth Member Enrollment, updated 07/11/2025

(If you were not enrolled in 4-H last year, please follow the process for a NEW 4-H member.) The 4-H program year runs from July 1 to June 30 of each year

4-H eligibility based on 4-H age:

Primary 4-H Members (also called Cloverbuds or Mini-members) – Must be 5 years old by December 31 of the program year. Primary members cannot enroll in large animal projects. Youth enrolling or turning nine after December 31 must participate as a Primary Member until the end of the program year (June 30).

4-H Members – Must be 9 years old by December 31 of the program year and may continue in the program until the end of the calendar year (December 31) in which they become 19 years of age.
