

Commit Message Format

<TYPE> <OPTIONAL CONTEXT>: SHORT TITLE

DESCRIPTION IN SEVERAL
LINES IF NEEDED

FOOTER

TYPE	MEANING
feature feat	new functionality
improvement i mprov	a change that restructures the code without modifying its external behavior
fix	a change that fixes an identified/registered bug
docs	a change that adds or updates docs
style	coding conventions etc
test	test added or updated
release	release number

SHORT TITLE	Succinct description of the change. - imperative mood, e.g. change, NOT <i>changed</i> or <i>changes</i> - all lower case, less stress on the pinky finger for additional SHIFT etc
DESCRIPTION	Motivation for the change using simple English phrases
FOOTER	Reference issues in a ticketing system.

- Non-trivial changes should be discussed in an issue first
- Develop in a topic branch, not main. Squash your commits

Add cart with checkout process. Integrate payment gateway.
