

Transferring from Jefferson Community College to Oswego

In addition to completing General Education requirements prior to transferring, the following list may help you with course selection during the first two years of study at Jefferson Community College. It is not required that these classes be complete prior to transferring, nor is this a comprehensive list. We encourage you to work closely with a transfer advisor as you plan your courses.

A few notes:

- If you finish the SUNY Gen Ed requirement prior to transferring, you are exempt from Oswego's local Gen Ed
- Transferring to Oswego with 57 or more credits will grant you Junior standing.
- Bachelor's degree graduation requirements:
 - 120-128 credits, depending on major
 - Minimum of 30 credits and ½ the major completed at Oswego
 - 42 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
