Difference Between Choice Ready Requirements and ND Scholarship Requirements

Be sure that students and parents understand the differences between the Choice Ready requirements and the North Dakota Scholarship requirements. The differences between the ND Scholarship requirements and the Choice Ready requirements are outlined in the table below:

	Choice Ready Requirements	ND Scholarship Requirements
Essential Skills Additional Indicators	Nine options to choose from, students must meet four of them	Eight options to choose from, students must meet four of them (Multicultural Awareness not an indicator for the ND Scholarship)
Grade-Point Average	2.8 GPA required for Postsecondary Ready Pathway	3.0 GPA required regardless of which pathways are used
ACT requirement	ACT subsection scores are one option for the Postsecondary Ready pathway	ACT of 24 is required for the Postsecondary Ready pathway
Additional Indicators- Postsecondary Ready Pathway	Students must meet two of the additional indicators listed if they do not meet the ACT subsection requirements	Students must meet two of the additional indicators in addition to scoring 24 or higher on the ACT
CREAM	Is one option for an indicator under the Postsecondary Ready Pathway	Is not an option as an indicator for the ND Scholarship
CTE Coursework	Completing three CTE courses is one option to meet the two additional indicators of the Workforce Ready pathway	Completing four credits of CTE with two of those credits in the same Coordinated Plan of Study is required for the Workforce Ready pathway if the students does not have three credits of the same World/Indigenous/Sign Language
World Language Coursework	Completing three World Language, Indigenous Language, or Sign Language courses is one option to meet the two additional indicators of the Workforce Ready pathway	Completing three credits of the same World Language, Indigenous Language, or Sign Language is required for the Workforce Ready pathway if the student does not have four credits of CTE with two of those credits in the same Coordinated Plan of Study
WorkKeys	WorkKeys scores of 4 or higher is one option to meet the two additional indicators of the Workforce Ready pathway	WorkKeys scores of 5 or higher are required for the Workforce Ready pathway if the student does not have an ACT of 24 or higher
Additional Indicators- Workforce Ready Pathway	Three CTE classes, three world language classes, and WorkKeys of 4 or higher can each be used to satisfy one of the additional indicators	Students must meet two of the additional indicators in addition to WorkKeys (5 or higher) and four credits of CTE (two of in same Plan of Study)/three credits of same language
ASVAB	Score of 31 is required for the Military Ready Pathway	Score of 50 is required for the Military Ready Pathway (unless the student has completed basic training)

Application Deadline

A completed application must be submitted online by June 13, 2025. A completed application will include your online application and return of the Scholarship Verification Form, completed by your authorizing FFA Advisor, 4-H Leader, or County Extension Agent.

Applications without a Scholarship Verification Form will not be accepted.



Six scholarships of \$1,000 each are available.



Scholarship Verification Form:

The Scholarship Verification Form is available in either a fillable PDF or standard PDF. Please have your FFA Advisor, 4-H Leader, or County Extension Agent complete the form and upload it to your application.

Eligibility Criteria:

Citizenship: U.S. citizens and North Dakota residents.

Academic Standing: Graduating high school seniors in 2025.

College/University Enrollment: Plan to attend an accredited post-secondary institution or trade school for the 2025-2026 academic year.

North Dakota State Fair Participation: At least 3 years of exhibiting or competing in 4-H or FFA at the North Dakota State Fair.

4-H or FFA Membership: Minimum of 4 years of membership in 4-H or FFA.

Reference: Verification form signed by a 4-H Leader, FFA Advisor, or County Extension Agent confirming eligibility requirements.

Attendance: Must attend scholarship drawing on July 23, 2025, at the Fair.

This scholarship is an equal opportunity regardless of race, creed, or gender.
