- 4. Budget Review and Updates: What was approved last year and what has been spent
 - a. Land Trust: \$127,420 approved, \$117,259 still remaining
 - i. All of Tech budget was used, do we need more, no also have other tech budget available not through Community Council, capacity increase slowly: building has room, but teacher capacity is full
 - b. TSSA: very restricted budget: Last year proposed \$172,829.40 -all allocated 2024-25: \$221,323
- 5. Data:

- a. Panorama Data: increase and decreases in how many students took the survey, it was an opt-in this year instead of opt- out which may have had an effect on this
- b. Absence rates: 9% increase in students that are attending 90% or more 33% not tardy
- Results: growth almost everywhere, except self efficacy for SPED -not all of the same students, possibly 7th graders that have just come to our school
 And Self efficacy for Hispanic went down just a tiny bit
- d. Passing and proficiency rates: 77% performed at proficient or above Misc: Parent Squared: attendance alert doesn't come until the evening- batching communication
