

2026 TaiwanCALL & GloCALL Joint Conference Proposal Template

This conference uses **double-blind review**. Both the reviewer and author identities are concealed from the reviewers, and vice versa, throughout the review process. Please kindly note that **when authors submit abstracts for review, the authors' information has to be blinded in the title, the contents, and the reference part**. After the paper is being accepted, the author information will be displayed in the final version of the submitted abstract.

Abstract (No more than 300 words)

This document provides a template for **2026 Taiwan CALL & Glo-CALL Joint Conference** proposal submission. Each proposal must include both a 50-word summary (to be included in the program) and a 300-word abstract (to be used by reviewers for adjudication). The summary and the abstract must be typed in Times New Roman font, 12-point without paragraph indentation. Each paragraph is separated by a single space as demonstrated below. Type all numbers—except those that begin a sentence—as Arabic numerals.

Each paragraph is separated with one single space as exemplified here. The text of the summary should not exceed 50 words. The text of the abstract should not exceed 300 words. There will be 3-5 keywords of your submission after the abstract.
