Rounds	WA1440 Gents/Ladies/50+/Metrics/Short Metrics Assembly 09:15 followed by practice.
Faces	Shooting at the 2 longer distances will be in ends of 6 arrows shot in 4 minutes on 122cm faces. Shooting at the 2 shorter distances will be in ends of 6 arrows shot in 4 minutes on individual, 6 zone 80cm faces. Except for barebow, longbow and junior archers who will shoot on a shared single full size 80 cm face. There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in 2 details.

Awards	Medals will be allocated based on entries for each category. 1-3 entries 1 st place medal
	2-5 entries 2 nd place medal
	6+ entries 3 rd place medal
	Juniors may enter the senior class on payment of senior fee but will not qualify for junior awards.
	Trophies: All trophies are returnable. Trophies to be held for one year only. Please return them in a clean condition to the tournament organiser on the day of the shoot or by Guaranteed Post during the week beforehand. Archers are awarded the trophies if they have the highest overall score for the weekend regardless of if they shoot 1 day or both days, if they have the highest score when the shoot is finished, they win.
Agents / Scorers	We ask anyone entering our competitions that require an agent/scorer that they bring someone along on the day of the competition to act as their agent/scorer.
	We have a limited field party at the club who will have other other duties on the day of the competition. So we are unlikely to have spare people to assist.
Dogs	Dogs are welcomed, however must stay behind the tent line. If they become noisy or aggressive, they must be removed from the archery field.
Target List	A target list will be available on the Cleadon Archers website as soon as reasonably possible after the closing date.

Smoking	Smoking (including vaping) must be behind the tents.
Food & Drinks	Hot food and drinks will be available to buy from Cleadon Archers. (Burgers, Hot Dogs, Chocolate bars, Crisps, Tea & Coffee).

Drugs	Archers competing in this event may be subject to drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply, non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering this competition, you consent to testing. If you are entering a minor into this competition you consent to the testing of that minor; this is in line with the UK AntiDoping Policy, Rule 5.7.2.
Liability	None of Cleadon Archers or Judges, or affiliated parties can accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury however caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.
Photos	Anyone wishing to use photographic/video equipment at a tournament must register prior to the start of the shoot. This includes mobile phone cameras.
GDPR	By entering Cleadon Archers competitions you agree that the information you provide may be shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, ArcheryGB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents relating to the event in the year of 2025. This information includes your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, e-mail address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information. A target list will be published prior to the event, available on the Cleadon Archers website and lanseo. Up-to-date information will be mostly available on lanseo. Results will be published as soon after the tournament as possible.
AGB Rules	By entering our competitions you are agreeing to abide by AGB Rules of shooting and the regulations of these tournaments. A Junior's parent/guardian must sign on behalf of the Junior, and in the case of a Junior under 16 yrs. must notify the Tournament Organiser of the senior person who will be taking due care and responsibility for that junior the whole time he/she is on Cleadon Archer's premises.
