## UNC System Minimum Admission Requirements

- 4 English
- 4 Math (including a higher level math above Math 3)
- 3 Science (Earth, Biology and a Physical Science)
- 2 Social Studies (US History plus one more)
- Two additional academic courses from english, mathematics, science, social studies, world languages, or computer science. Note: these courses should be selected in alignment with a student's academic and career objectives. Completion of two sequential world language courses is recommended.

Minimum GPA for class of 2026: 2.5 (weighted)

Minimum ACT/SAT for class of 2026: Standardized Test Scores: Students with a weighted High School GPA greater than or equal to 2.50 and less than 2.80 are required to submit a standardized test score of a 17 or higher on the ACT or a 930 or higher on the SAT.

## Sending Records/Transcripts

**Standardized Test Scores:** In order for test scores (SAT, ACT) to be official, they must be sent directly to the college from College Board at [www.sat.collegeboard.org](https://www.sat.collegeboard.org) or from the ACT at [www.act.org](https://www.act.org).

AP Exam Scores should also be sent from College Board (APstudents.collegeboard.org)

**Sending Transcripts:**

**To send to any College, University, or Community College in North Carolina:**

For all NC schools, transcripts must be sent electronically by the student through the CFNC website, [www.cfnc.org](https://www.cfnc.org).

- 1) If you do not have a CFNC account, you'll need to create one by clicking on "Create My CFNC Account"
- 2) Click on "Apply To College" tab

- 3) Click on "Request Your Transcript" and follow directions

\*There is no charge for transcripts sent through CFNC if a current student in InfiniteCampus/enrolled at SHS.

## **To send transcripts for scholarship applications, out of state colleges, universities and community colleges, and**

**NCAA:** All transcripts for out of state schools and scholarship applications must be ordered from:

## **How to send transcripts using the Common Application, Coalition App, and HBCU Common App:**

In these application portals, list your counselor’s name and email address. *Ensure the email address is typed correctly.* Your counselor will upload a copy of your transcript and complete the counselor section of the recommendation.

## **College Tuition Information**

### **Residency Determination Services Interview Form**

All students should complete Residency Determination at <https://ncresidency.cfnc.org/residencyInfo>

- Only has to be completed once per child.
- Use same log in info. as student log in for CFNC.org
- High School student will need some parent/legal guardian information: social security numbers (or other identifiable number), tax return information, vehicle registration number, driver’s license and more.

**Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA): Completed each year, beginning Oct. 1.** Determines if student or parents/guardians are eligible for any grants, loans, work study. Colleges have varying deadlines for this. [FAFSA.gov](http://FAFSA.gov)
