4 two-pocket folders, one of each color: red, yellow, blue, and green  
2 college ruled spiral notebooks (unless student needs wider lines then purchase wide ruled)  
1 college ruled composition notebooks (unless student needs wider lines then purchase wide ruled)  
2 fine and 1 extra fine point black Sharpie (any brand for outlining or making print stand out)  
2 blue or black ball point pens , gel pens are fine. ( Keep a supply to replenish during the year)  
1 box of #2 pencils, sharpened  
1 eraser (white preferred but pink is OK) Please put your name on it.  
1 box of 10 Crayola brand fine tip markers  
1 box of 24 Crayola colored pencils, sharpened  
1 package of college ruled loose leaf paper with punched holes  
1 personal hand held pencil sharpener- one that fits in a pencil box/pouch  
1 pencil pouch or box that can hold all writing tools.  
1 water bottle for daily use in class  
1 pair of scissors  
1 Daily planner for the 2025-26 school year

### **Optional Supplies:**

1 ream of white copy paper- community resource  
2 boxes of tissues- community resource  
2 containers of disinfectant wipes (**COHOLAN ONLY**)  
2 glue sticks
