Hillsdale High School is working hard to address the high cost of living and opportunity gap that exists for so many of our students and families living on the margins in our community. Our program has been positively impacting students at Hillsdale for over seven years. As a result, on June 12, 2025, the SMUHSD Board of Trustees unanimously approved funding for an extension of the program, to additional schools in the district. This initiative, known as Empower San Mateo, will ensure that students and families living on the margins in San Mateo and Foster City have access to the opportunities and coordinated support they deserve. ETA Student graduates shared what the program did for them:

- "ETA helped me learn that I can be a leader...a leader is someone who wants to inspire by setting a good example. And before ETA, I thought I reached my full potential as a student, but ETA showed me that I had a lot to learn."
- "They told me how to support my community by being everything they taught us from being a leader and making sacrifices and being the best version of myself. They helped me achieve these things."
