Kiowa County Historic Preservation Commission Minutes from April 7, 2021

Barnett completed letter of information about historic tax credits to be sent to business property owners who have historic commercial buildings in the county. A list of seven businesses was made for the initial mailing. Response to the letters will determine further action.

Courkamp has included an electronic nomination form for historic property designation application on the KCHPC website.

KCHPC will start looking over its bylaws to determine if they need to be updates.
